The nomination of Brett Kavanaugh to the U.S. Supreme Court was unexpectedly put on hold when he mysteriously disappeared from the offices of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit. An FBI search of the building, and the Judge's home found no sign of the Judge.

Courthouse staff was interviewed at length, but no one could give an accurate account of what might have happened to the Judge. The only interview giving any information was with Ms. Brittany Knauer, a file clerk in the Appeal Court's offices. Ms. Knauer said that she remembered someone - she could give no description - meeting with Judge Kavanaugh. In the words of FBI Special Agent Tom Moffat, "She almost sounded like she'd been there, but her answers were all far too vague to be of any use."

In an interview with the Washington Post, Ms. Knauer could only add that she "really, really liked beer."

The Senate voted (68-31) on Saturday to suspend any final vote on Judge Kavanaugh's nomination until he is found. The White House would not comment except to state its continued support of Judge Kavanaugh and the hope that he would return as soon as possible from wherever he was. The FBI will continue its search.
